

Gilham Parking Lot Procedures

THE DO'S AND DON'TS OF DROP OFF/PICK UP

The following support and promote student safety:

DO drop off/pick up in the designated drop off/pick up area

DO park and walk your student in utilizing the crosswalk and give them hugs and set them up for success before you head off to your day.

DO pay attention to the crossing guard and wait for them to direct you.

DO bid on the Auction parking spot when the time comes, if you want to park there.

DO organize car seats and seating arrangements so that your student can exit from the passenger side of the vehicle during drop off and enter on that side during pick up and not be at risk for getting hit by a passing car.

DO set the example for your child by modeling respect and patience with staff members assisting with pick-up safety.

DON'T drop off students anywhere but in the designated drop off area (see the map and note the curb is yellow). NO stopping between the signs indicating NO pause parking.

DON'T exit your vehicle in the drop off/pick up line

DON'T park and then signal your student to walk out to the parking lot to meet you.

DON'T enter the staff parking area at anytime between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

DON'T cut across the parking lot when you are walking, as it backs up traffic and puts one at risk for being hit by a car trying to exit.

DON'T drive the wrong way in the parking lanes. There is only one exit lane.

DON'T park in the Auction Winners parking spot if you are not the current Auction Winner.
